

FALL 2018 IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

****** REQUIREMENT FOR INCOMING 12TH GRADE STUDENTS******

The Ohio Department of Health requires that all students who will be entering the 12th grade in the fall of 2018 have one dose of meningococcal vaccine (MCV4) given on or after the student's 16th birthday. If your child received one meningococcal vaccine before their 16th birthday, they are required to have a 2nd vaccine. Documentation of this vaccine must be on record at Warren High School before the first day of school in August.

****** REQUIREMENT FOR INCOMING 7TH GRADE STUDENTS******

The Ohio Department of Health requires that all students who will be entering the 7th grade in the fall of 2018 have documentation of a meningococcal vaccine (MCV4) along with an updated tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis (Tdap) booster. Documentation of these vaccines must be on record at Warren Middle School before the first day of school in August.

******REQUIREMENT FOR INCOMING KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS******

The Ohio Department of Health requires that all students who will be entering kindergarten in the fall of 2018 have documentation of the following vaccines:

DTap/DT- 5 doses (Dose 5 only required if 4th dose was given prior to the 4th birthday)

Polio- 4 doses (Dose 4 only required if 3rd dose was given prior to the 4th birthday)

Hepatitis B- 3 doses

MMR- 2 doses

Varicella- 2 doses (or documentation of having the disease)

Documentation of these vaccines must be on record at Little Hocking Elementary/Warren Elementary before the first day of school in August.

If your child has not received these vaccines, please arrange for him/her to have the vaccines through your doctor/healthcare provider, the Washington County Health Department, or the Marietta City Health Department. The Washington County Health Department (342 Muskingum Drive, Marietta, 740-374-2782) offers vaccines on Wednesdays from 1pm-6pm and on Fridays from 9am-4pm. The Marietta City Health Department (304 Putnam Street, Marietta, 740-373-0611) offers vaccines on Mondays from 8:00 am until 4:00 pm and on the first Monday of every month from 8:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. Vaccines are also available at the Belpre City Building (715 Park Drive, Belpre, 740-423-7592) on Fridays from 9am-1pm. Many local pharmacies including White Oak Pharmacy in Barlow (740-678-2384) also offers the Tdap and meningococcal vaccines for 7th and 12th grade students. For details on insurance coverage and cost, please contact the organizations listed.
