

He attended Marietta High School and graduated in 1981. He played JV and varsity football as well as varsity baseball at the high school level. In the fall of 1981 he enrolled in Marietta College. While attending Marietta College Dennis was a member of the highly successful Pioneer baseball team. After graduating from Marietta College in 1985 with a

bachelor's degree in education, he married his high school sweetheart Jennifer Miracle in June of 1985. In August of 1985, Dennis was hired at Warren High School as a special education teacher. Later, he earned his masters in education from Mary Grove College.

- He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Williamstown, where he was a Trustee for the church. He also was a Sunday school teacher and a leader in the youth fellowship group.
