

# Warren Local Schools Project

**Please be advised:** construction of the new elementary school was started on Monday, April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 and the high school construction is scheduled to start in July 2019.

The onsite construction work will increase the vehicular traffic at the main road and school entrances. The additional traffic caused by the construction activities may affect the daily commutes of students, staff, visitors, and parents. Please allow additional time for your commutes to and from school.

In addition, the drivers of trucks and mobile equipment may have obstructed views that can make it difficult to see pedestrians and/or vehicles. Maintain vigilance and use extra caution as drivers, bikers, and pedestrians when navigating the area adjacent to trucks and equipment. The greatest hazard created by the construction work will be the truck traffic and equipment traffic in and out of the site. Please be very cautious of your surroundings while visiting the Warren Local Schools during the construction of your new schools.

An active construction site is a very dynamic work environment. Due to the changing conditions, large trucks, and moving equipment, construction sites can be dangerous to those people unfamiliar with the work. The importance of maintaining a secure worksite and keeping unregistered visitors and students out of the site cannot be stressed enough.

The construction work area will be defined by a six-foot high construction fence. The clearly marked construction entrances will be open to facilitate construction activities. Conspicuously posted warning signs will be posted at each entrance. The construction management team will work diligently to manage the industry specific health and safety hazards. The general public will not be allowed in the designated construction work areas.
